Students must write five provincial exams, one exam in each area, to graduate. • Some Grade 12 courses satisfy a Grade 11 and Grade 12 requirement but do not count as dual credit. For example, First Nations Studies 12 meets the Grade 11 Social Studies Requirement and a Grade 12 Level Course Elective but the student only receives credit for completion of one course. If a student applies one course to two requirements, another course would need to be completed to satisfy the 80-credit requirement. See a counsellor for further information. • Most elective courses offered at Stelly's (excluding some PE courses, Modern Languages and Sciences) meet the Applied Skill/Fine Arts requirement.
