Day 1 / Day 2 Schedules

At the outset, I would like to say that we are working very hard to have all of our students here in a healthy and safe environment as much as possible. Because of a variety of changes and adjustments over the last 4 weeks, including a number of students opting for remote and/or distance learning (which has lowered many of our class sizes), and having now learned a great deal more about classroom instruction in a Pandemic/COVID environment, the number of classes that operate on a Day1/Day2 schedule will be fewer as of October 13th, the mid-point of the Quarter. There will be some that do remain on the Day1/Day2 schedule. This is due to the health and safety requirements and the nature of the course, the equipment handling in that course, the multi-grade and multi-course configuration of the class and the number of cohorts scheduled for that class. Please contact Mr. Redlin if you have any questions regarding any class moving to, or remaining on a Day1/Day 2 schedule.

Bussing

Extra bussing will continue at lunch time to take students home that are not expected in the afternoon due to the Day1/Day2 configuration. If parents/guardians are picking students up at lunch, please arrive to pick up your child at 11:30 on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays and 11:15 on Wednesdays and Fridays. Thank you.

School Sports

Currently all secondary schools in B.C. are in 'Stage 2' of the Return to School Sports plan. Within this Stage 2, schools can engage in some activities within a small group of student-athletes and/or within cohorts with strict adherence to safety protocols and physical distancing. At the moment, only some volleyball activities have begun. Once, and if, we move to 'Stage 3,' some inter-school activities and games, with modification and restrictions, will begin. If you have any questions about athletics in general, our Athletic Co-Directors Mr. Hart and Mr. Braun are a great resource.
