# STELLY'S FAREWELL CAR PARADE 2021

**Wednesday, June 30<sup>th</sup>!** This is your day to get dressed up again if you like, decorate your car, and strut your stuff to the communities of Brentwood Bay and Saanichton! Your entire community wants to celebrate with you by waving, clapping, and yelling congrats! This is also your final chance to celebrate as a Stelly's 2021 grad and wave farewell to your teachers.

A special grad banner has been provided, so please display it proudly on your car, make plans to join the procession on June 30th and most of all have fun!

**START UP INSTRUCTIONS FOR GRADS:** The arrival schedule will be staggered using the grad's last names beginning with A-G starting at 1:30; H-P starting at 1:40 and Q-Z starting at 1:50. The parade will commence at 2.00 pm so don't be late!

Many local businesses and staff plus grad families will be supporting you as you drive around the route - this is going to be a fun event - honk, wave, enjoy!*


*Everyone should tune into 101.9 FM from 1.30 pm as they will be supporting our parade. CFUV is a non-profit, campus/community radio station at UVic and will be playing the songs grad students selected. A souvenir film will be made of the parade and this will be available on the Stelly's YouTube Video channel from July 4th.*

**Whilst waiting for the parade to start, if you need to get out of your car please wear a mask. Please stay in your vehicles at all times during the procession.** The procession will begin at Stelly's High School entering in the bus lane and looping through the drive-through area to wave at the Stelly's staff. We will then proceed around the student parking lot and exit right back onto Stelly's Cross Rd. From there we will continue to Wallace Dr. to begin the public procession route (see Map #2). All vehicles **MUST** approach the school from West, there will **be no left turns** into the school. To accommodate this route, the entrance and exits have been reversed for better flow.



**FAREWELL CAR PROCESSION RULES AND GUIDELINES:**

1. Please observe Dr. Bonnie Henry's orders at all times, whether you are a driver or a spectator-maintain your physical distance at all times. *Be Safe – Be Calm – Be Kind.*



2. Washrooms will not be available in the school, please use the facilities before starting car procession.

3. This is not a parade in the sense that the route is not closed off to the general public.

4. Rules of the road (including the Motor Vehicle Act) apply.

5. Everyone must wear seatbelts and act in a safe manner at all times.

6. No over-taking or racing.

7. No one shall ride on the exterior of a 'float', in the box of a truck, or similar conveyance.

8. Vehicles must stop at all stop signs/traffic lights as usual, following the normal rules of the road.

9. Since the roads remain open to the public, it is possible for other traffic to find themselves amidst the grad vehicles.

10. Participants are required to remain in their vehicles at all times.

11. Please drive carefully and follow the lead car. **We plan to drive the route twice.** The parade will be filmed and videoed, so smile and wave if you see a camera pointing at your car.

12. As mentioned above, tune into CFUV 101.9 FM. They will be playing the songs YOU choose and there will also be some special dedications shared during the 2 hour program to support the Stelly's Farewell Car Parade.

13. A voucher for a coffee/tea will be given to each Vintage Car driver to be used at the Brentwood Bay Village Empourium, at your convenience.
